**APPEAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
PKNIC - INTERNET DOMAIN REGISTRATION POLICY**

This form shall be used by Appellants whose application/registration has been rejected by PKNIC and are aggrieved or wish to challenge this decision of PKNIC by lodging an Appeal with the Domain Name Dispute Resolution Centre (DNDRC) for its recommendation within 14 days of the posting of the decision of rejection of PKNIC under the pursuant to the PKNIC - Internet Domain Registration Policy, Uniform Policy for Domain Name Dispute Resolution, approved by the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) on October 24, 1999 (the Policy), the Rules for Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy, approved by ICANN on October 24, 1999 (the Rules) and the DNDRC latest Supplemental Rules (if any) for Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (the Supplemental Rules)

JURISDICTION OF DNDRC OFFICE TO ADMINISTER THE PROCEEDINGS

For Applicant/Registrant/Appellant for .pk Tld Domain Names from PKNIC (directly or indirectly) the PKNIC - Internet Domain Registration Policy functions as an agreement that mandatorily gives arbitration jurisdiction for any and all domain name disputes to DNDRC

For the Applicant/Registrant/Appellant who is not an Applicant for .pk Tld Domain Names from PKNIC (directly or indirectly), such Appeal hereby submits to the jurisdiction of the Pakistan Office of the DNDRC to administer and arbitrate the domain name dispute proceedings referred to in this Appeal.

The Applicant/Registrant/Appellant agrees that recommendation of DNDRC shall be final and binding on the Applicant/Registrant/Appellant. However, the recommendation of DNDRC under this paragraph will be non-binding on PKNIC and enforcement or implementation will be at the discretion of PKNIC.

- (vi) Any communication by a party shall be copied to the other party and the DNDRC’s Pakistan Office.

14 CERTIFICATE

The Appellant agrees that its claims and remedies concerning the registration of the domain name, the dispute, or the dispute’s resolution shall be solely against the domain-name holder and waives all such claims and remedies against (a) DNDRC, or any of its Offices, or any Panelist(s), except in the case of mala fide, (b) the registrar, (c) the registry administrator, and (d) the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, as well as their directors, officers, employees, and agents.

The Appellant certifies that the information contained in this Appeal is to the best of the Appellant’s knowledge, complete and accurate, that this Appeal is not being presented for any improper purpose, such as to harass, and that the assertions in this Appeal are warranted under the Rules and under applicable law, as it now exists or as it may be extended by a good-faith and reasonable argument.
